Host Family Agreement

Under the terms of the Agreement, Host Families are expected to:

- 1. Act as a judicious, caring parent and regard the international student as a family member, keeping information about the student confidential at all times.**
- 2. Provide activities and/or experiences that will expose the student to our Canadian culture while respecting the culture and values of the student.**
- 3. Provide the student with a clean, private room, a bed with clean linen, wireless access, and a study area with appropriate lighting. Computer use will be in accordance with the Peace River North School District Computer & Internet Use Policy.**
- 4. Agree that students will be expected to keep his/her room tidy and clean up after themselves when using other areas of the home.**
- 5. Permit the student access to telephone, television, stereo, laundry facilities, a key to the house and provide daytime phone numbers where the Host Family can be contacted.**
- 6. Provide the student, during the first or second day, written house rules setting clear, reasonable and age-appropriate rules. This should include information regarding abstinence from the use of drugs, alcohol or other controlled substances as well as any instructions regarding home safety.**
- 7. Provide the student with 3 meals per day 7 days a week: breakfast (if the student makes his/her own breakfast, provide the ingredients), lunch, and dinner (even if the student is late). The meals must be of sufficient quantity and quality to provide a balanced diet.**
- 8. Show student how to use transit, bank and library cards.**
- 9. Refrain from allowing an International Student to drive any motorized vehicle or participate in any activity that may be considered dangerous or inappropriate. Contact the Peace River North School District Principal of International Education, if uncertain whether an activity is inappropriate.**
- 10. Ensure that ENGLISH ONLY is spoken when the student is present.**

11. Agree to undergo a criminal record check (if not already completed), a copy of which will be on file with Peace River North School District International Program.
12. Bring any unacceptable behaviour of the student to the attention of the Peace River North School District International Office. If the problem cannot be rectified, the student will be moved and the Host Family will be provided with another student as soon as possible.
13. Notify the Peace River North School District International Office of any time that the Host Family parents are away from home.
14. Notify the Peace River North School District International Office of any medical emergency or accident involving the International Student.
15. Notify the Peace River North School District International Office of any change in contact information (phone numbers, email addresses etc.)
16. Understand that the Peace River North School District International Program can terminate any homestay arrangement if the student presents good reason or if any of the above standards have not been met.
17. Understand that if a student decides to change host family for personal reasons, the Host Family is entitled to 15 days notice. *If the does not wish to remain in the home for the month, a minimum of \$350.00 in lieu of notice is payable to the Host Family.*
